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National Society of Accountants Offering Enrolled Agent Exam Review Course

Course offered in connection with NSA Annual Meeting

Alexandria, VA, June 22, 2010 — In connection with its upcoming 65th NSA Annual Meeting, August 18-21, 2010, at the Hyatt Regency Crystal City in Arlington, VA, the National Society of Accountants (NSA) is offering a three-day Enrolled Agent Exam Review Course August 16-18, 2010.

The Enrolled Agent Review Course provides a comprehensive review of all topics covered on the IRS Enrolled Agent exam, ranging from individuals to partnerships to corporations to property to estate and gift taxes to ethics and more. All facets of the exam will be covered, including test-taking tips, memory devices, planning tips, and war stories to help students better understand the material. Comprehensive handouts with numerous test questions will be provided to reinforce all learning concepts. The course provides 24 hours of CPE credit.

The course will not only help people pass the Enrolled Agent exam the first time, but is also an excellent resource for staff training on tax issues and as a refresher course on tax issues.

The course can also help people prepare for exams offered by the Accreditation Council for Accountancy and Taxation (ACAT). These ACAT exams are needed for individuals to obtain credentials such as the Accredited Tax Preparer (ATP) and Accredited Tax Advisor (ATA).

The depth of information taught in this course is also more than sufficient to prepare for the IRS tax preparer tests expected to be offered next year.
